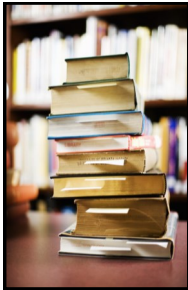
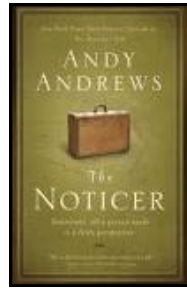

November

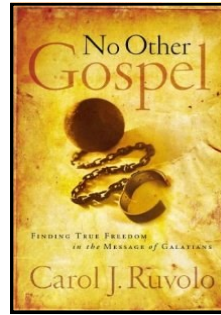

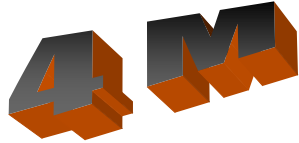

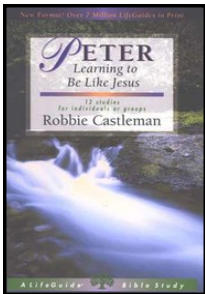

WITH BILLY GRAHAM

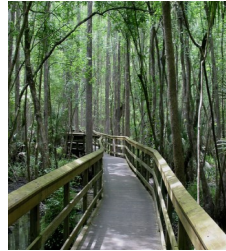

- **Look Around:** Make a short list of friends, family and neighbors who need Jesus.
- **Look Up:** Pray every day for each name on your list
- **Look Out:** Think of ways to build relationships with them.
- **Look Forward:** Prepare to invite the people on your list to a party or gathering in your home, where you will watch the *My Hope America* programs, give a short salvation testimony (faith story), and invite your guests to receive Christ and begin to follow Him.

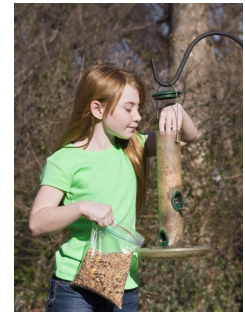

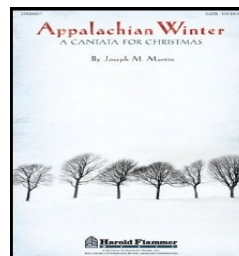

Sacred Harp tunes are re-tooled for Advent and stand alongside new versions of Shaker hymns and Appalachian melodies.

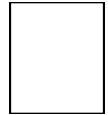
